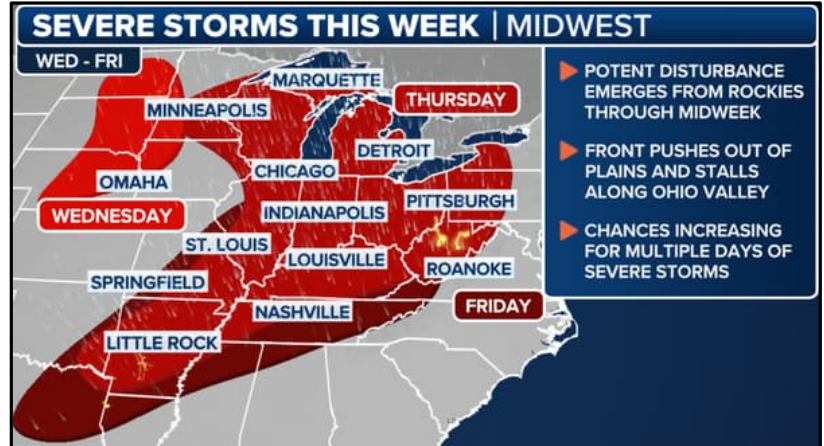

Severe Weather Threat

Midwest

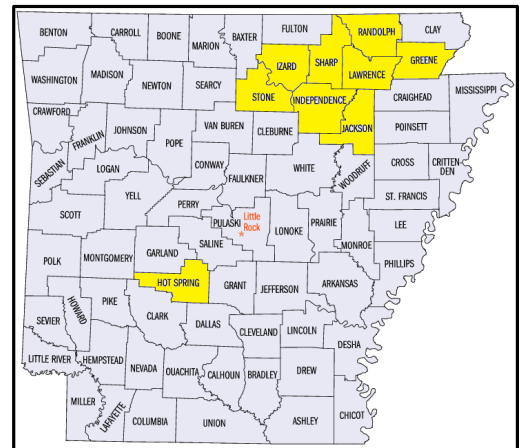
- Tens of millions of people from the Upper Midwest to the Ohio Valley are on alert as a multiday severe weather threat begins Wednesday.
- Forecasters warn of storms capable of producing tornadoes, large hail and damaging wind gusts.
- The FOX Forecast Center said the strongest instability and storm energy on Wednesday will be found from the Kansas-Nebraska border northward into the Dakotas beginning late Wednesday afternoon.
- Large hail is expected to be the primary threat, with a growing risk for tornadoes to develop later Wednesday evening. Thursday the severe weather threat will shift east.
- More than 16 million people in cities like Chicago and Naperville in Illinois, Milwaukee and Madison in Wisconsin and Grand Rapids in Michigan are included in the threat.



Disaster Declaration Activity

DR-4865 Arkansas

- On May 13, President Donald J. Trump approved a Major Disaster in Arkansas in response to severe storms and tornadoes that struck the state on March 14-15.
- Individual Assistance was declared for Greene, Hot Spring, Independence, Izard, Jackson, Lawrence, Randolph, Sharp, and Stone counties.
- A powerful storm system resulted in a multi-day outbreak of severe storms across Arkansas beginning Friday, March 14, and continuing through Saturday, March 15.
- Damage assessments revealed 156 homes were destroyed, 93 with major damage, 88 with minor damage and another 119 affected.
- This tornado outbreak is the second largest since the tornado outbreak on April 25, 2011.
- On March 21, 2025, Governor Sarah Huckabee Sanders requested individual assistance for nine counties.
- The State of Arkansas received a formal denial from the federal government for Individual Assistance on April 11.
- On April 18, 2025, Governor Sanders appealed FEMA's decision to deny Arkansas' Major Disaster Declaration for Individual Assistance.
